## MATERIALS:

2-1/2 yards Blender Black, includes binding

1-1/4 yards Forest

1/2 yard Blender Silver

1/8 yard Blender Fuchsia

1/4 yard Animal Toss

1/8 yard Blender Royal

1/8 yard Pears

1/8 yard Grapevine

1/8 yard Blender Grass

1/8 yard Blender Sky

2 yards Word Stripe

1-7/8 yards Animal Toss (Directional)

Fusible Web

*READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING THIS PROJECT. FABRICS ARE SEWN RIGHT-SIDES TOGETHER USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER;*

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### From Blender Silver Fabric:

Using the larger circle template, copy [13] circles to the fusible web. Fuse to the wrong side of the Blender Silver fabric. Cut the circles out.

### From Blender Black Fabric:

Cut [4] — 10-1/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [13] — 10-1/4" squares

Subcut [12] — 5" squares

Cut [2] — 5-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 5-3/4" squares, cut diagonally twice

Cut [4] — 2-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [48] — 2-3/4" squares

Cut [8] — 2-1/2" × WOF, binding

### From Animal Toss Fabric:

Trace smaller circles onto paper backed fusible. Fuse to back of the fabric. Cut out [12] circles.

Cut [7] — 6-1/2" × WOF strips

### From Forest Fabric:

Cut [4] — 10-1/4" × WOF strips (directional)

Subcut [13] — 10-1/4" squares. Cut the squares diagonally twice. You will use only the bottom triangle with the trees pointing up to the point.

### From Pacific NW Words Stripe Fabric:

Cut [4] — 3-1/2" × LOF strips

### From each of Blender Fuchsia, Blender Royal, Pears, Grape Vine, Blender Grass and Blender Sky Fabric:


Cut [1] — 3-1/8" × WOF strips

Subcut [8] — 3-1/8" squares, cut once diagonally

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

### Mountain Block

1. Fuse the Blender Silver circle to the middle of the Blender Black 10-1/4" squares.
2. Cut the squares once corner to corner as shown. Cut the left triangle in half as shown. Discard the bottom small triangle,



3. Sew the left smaller Blender Black/Moon triangle to [1] Forest triangle left side as shown.
4. Sew the large right side triangle from Step 2 to the unit from Step 3 as shown. Make [13].



5. Using your favorite machine applique stitch (we used a blanket stitch), sew around the moon. Trim to 9-1/2" square. Make [13].

### Star Block

1. Fuse Animal Toss circles to the Blender Black 5" square, centering the circle.
2. Using your choice of applique stitch, stitch around the circles. Make [12].



3. Make star points by sewing the triangles cut from the various Blenders to the triangles cut

from the Blender Black 5-3/4" squares. Trim the Flying Geese to 2-3/4" x 5". Make [48].



4. Sew the Black 2-3/4" squares to right and left sides of [24] flying geese units.



5. Sew the remaining flying geese units to the right and left sides of the circle center.




6. Sew the Star blocks together as shown. Trim to 9-1/2" square. You will have [2] of each of the [6] Blender colors.



## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew the center of the quilt as shown with [5] rows of [5] blocks. Alternate star and moon blocks, arranging the colors as you wish.



## BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Measure from the center of the quilt to determine your length. This is a double mitered border; you will sew both borders together and miter them as a single piece.

2. Sew the PNW Words Strip 3-1/2" x LOF strips end to end, matching if necessary (you may need to do this for the words).
3. Sew the Animal Toss 6-1/2" x WOF strips together end to end.
4. Then, sew the strips from Step 2 and 3 together along the long edge to form one long strip as shown.



5. Measure the sides of the quilt and cut length to your measurement PLUS 18" for the miter. Make sure you leave a 1/4" to get your corners. Sew the strip set to left and right sides of the quilt.
6. Measure the width and cut and attach in the same way. Miter using your preferred method. If you've never mitered a border, pull up a video on it to see how its done.



## FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind with the Blender Black 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
4. Label & Enjoy!
